### What Should I Give?

Cash gifts set up for monthly contributions allow even modest sized gifts to become large ones over time. A weekly gift of \$10 over the three-year length of the campaign results in a gift of \$1,560. Giving from other resources enables even larger gifts. Consider one or more of these, or a portion of one of them:

- Proceeds from sale of stocks or other assets.
- Revenue from sale of assets no longer in needed such as an RV, boat, extra vehicle, or vacation property.
- Donor Advised Funds.
- A portion of mandatory withdrawals from retirement funds.
- Cash rewards from credit cards.
- Tax refunds.
- Year-end bonuses.
- An inheritance.
- Paid up insurance policies.

Because tax implications may apply for some methods of donating, always discuss your plans with a financial advisor. Gifts to the campaign are tax-deductible as gifts to a non-profit organization. Check with a tax consultant for details.

#### **How Should I Give?**

Choose the method that works best for your situation. For example:

- Combine a modest weekly or monthly gift with one of the alternative gift options above.
- Review your monthly non-essential expenses and consider donating all or part of what you typically spent on one of them to this special all-congregational major project.
- Set up an electronic auto donation plan or set your personal bank bill pay program to give on a regular schedule.

However you choose to give – know that every gift of any size and any frequency is an important part of everyone working together to reach the campaign goals.
